In case of holiday for a practical session, the deadline will be postponed to its immediate next week for that practical session

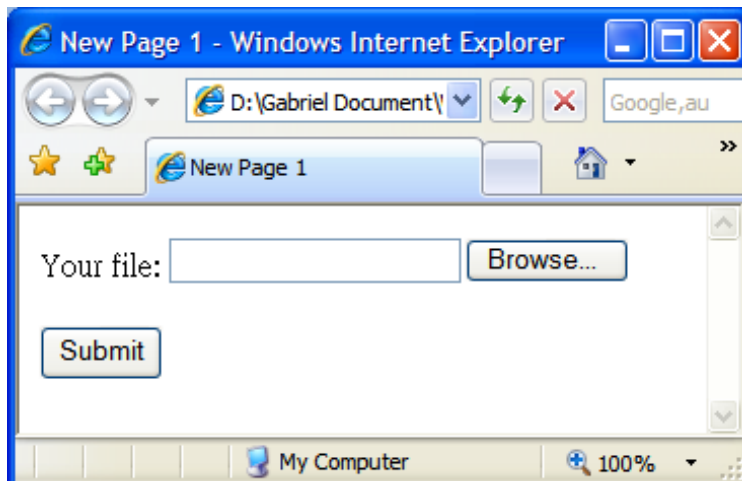

Marking guideline: For each task, 0 marks for doing nothing; 1.5 marks for partial completion; 2.5 marks for completion (no mistake/error).

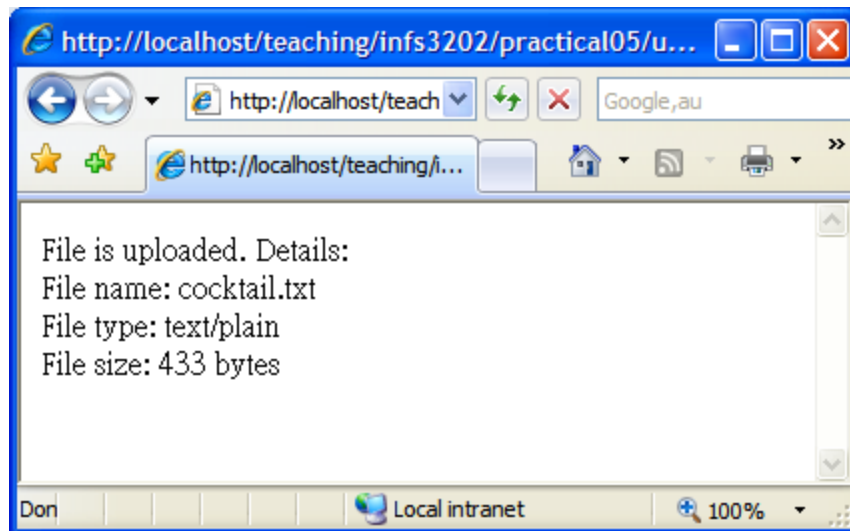
#### Task 1 – Upload a File using PHP

In this task, you are going to upload a file using PHP. Guideline:

1. Create a very simple form called form.html:



2. When the user clicks the Submit button, it will upload the file to the directory: H:\webpages\userFiles, and the following screen will appeared:



where “cocktail.txt” is the file that the user uploaded.

3. You have to show to your tutors that: (1) The file can successfully upload to the destination directory; and (2) Upload two different file types.

### **Task 2 – Upload a File using JSP**

In this task, you are going to repeat Task 1, but using JSP. You can write your own bean or use any existing open source.
