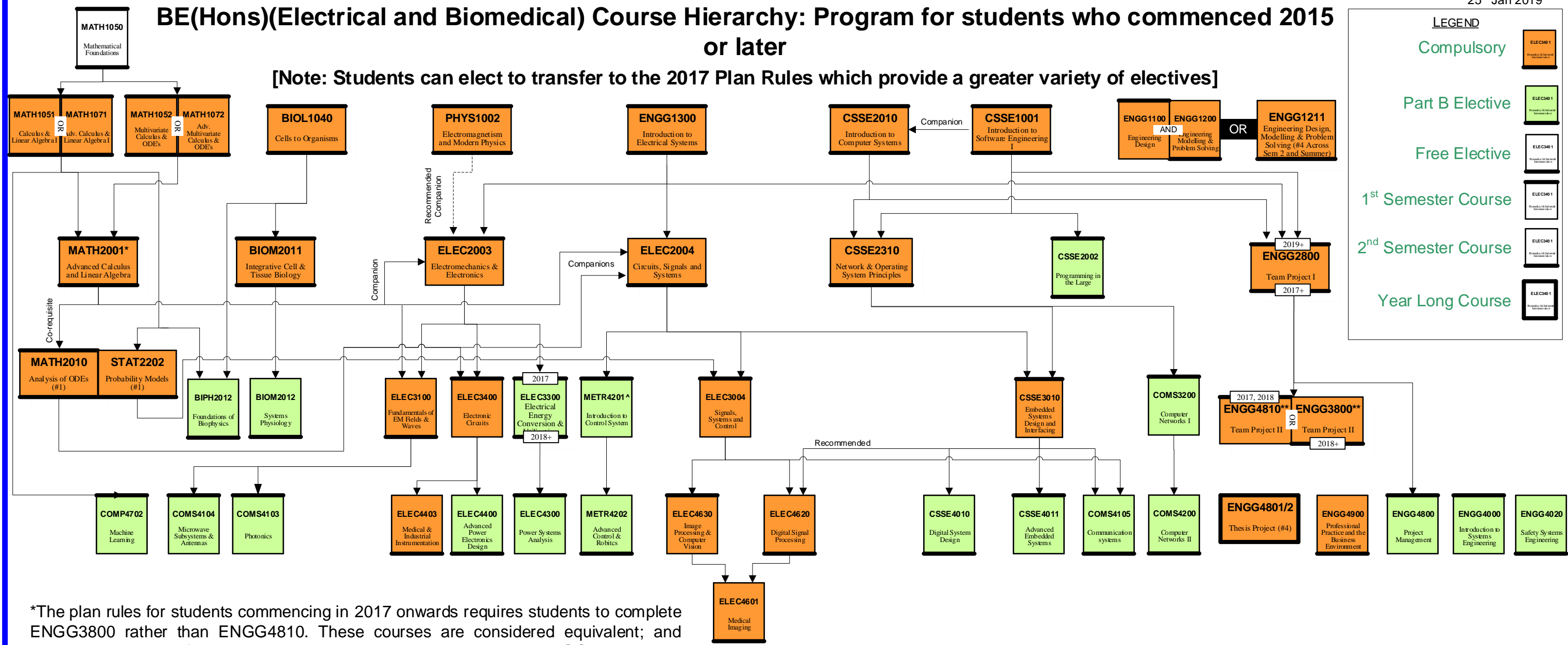


BE(Hons)(Electrical and Biomedical) Course Hierarchy: Program for students who commenced 2015 or later

[Note: Students can elect to transfer to the 2017 Plan Rules which provide a greater variety of electives]



*The plan rules for students commencing in 2017 onwards requires students to complete ENGG3800 rather than ENGG4810. These courses are considered equivalent; and students enrolled before 2017 may complete either course. Note, ENGG4810 will be offered for the last time in semester 1, 2018. ENGG3800 will be offered for the first time in semester 2, 2018.

 - This mud map shows only prerequisites on the BE (electrical & biomedical) course list, and does not show recommended pre-requisites, or pre-requisites which are not on the course list. Dual Major in Electrical and Biomedical Engineering

Students must choose #60 Electrical & Biomedical Engineering courses + #4 Free Electives:

- All of the **orange (#56)**.
- Two (#4) of the **green** Part B electives, of which at least 1 must be at level 4.
- Two (#4) Free Electives (including MATH1050 if no Maths C)
